# Christian Leaders of the Future, class of 2025 Application Instructions

Carefully read ALL of the following instructions. ONLY properly submitted applications will be considered.

In order to apply, you will send **ONE email** containing the following:

- 1. Your **application** (see questions below) AS A PDF ATTACHMENT.
- 2. Basic information (see bullets below), IN THE BODY OF THE EMAIL.
- 3. Email addresses for your references (see application question 8) COPIED IN THE "CC" FIELD.

### **APPLICATION (attach as a PDF)**

**NOTES:** PLEASE PROOFREAD! We recommend typing in Microsoft Word and using spell check and the word-count tool before finally SAVING your application **AS A PDF.** *Also, do not send a link to your PDF. Simply attach it to the email.* 

- 1. Describe a specific situation where you lived out your faith in a way that was challenging. (250 words max)
- 2. Briefly share how you came to know Christ. (250 words max)
- 3. What activities are you involved in at church, at school and in the community? (200 words max)
- 4. What is your favorite Bible passage and why? (200 words max)
- 5. What Christian leader in your life has impacted you the most, and how? (200 words max)
- 6. How do you plan to intentionally live out your faith in an increasingly anti-Christian world? (250 words max)

- 7. What career do you believe God might be calling you to pursue, and why? (100 words max)
- 8. Please provide the **names**, **phone numbers**, and **email addresses** of 3 adult references (not family members) who can vouch for your Christian faith and leadership. (You'll also copy them when you submit your application.)

- Church where you attend or are a member
- Your mailing address, city and ZIP code
- Your email address

- Father's name and employer if applicable

Don't forget to copy the email addresses for your 3 references in the "cc" field!

- Is your application (with answers to all 8 questions) attached as a PDF?
- Is your basic information in the body of the email?
- Are your 3 references copied in the "cc" field?
